The speaker today has been a pastor at Souderton for the past thirteen years. He was raised on a farm near Bath, Northampton County, Pa. He received his education in a rural school and then at Bath. He graduated at Muhlenberg College, Allentown, in 1905. After three years of study at Lutheran Theological Seminary at Philadelphia, he was ordained as a Lutheran Minister. Before coming to Souderton he served parishes at Windgap and Womelsdorf. He has been instrumental in building a number of churches, the last one being the beautiful church in Souderton. He is constantly in demand as a speaker at public occasions.
