At a meeting held July 11th, your Executive Committee found that Federal Government restrictions make it impossible to hold a Kulp Family Reunion this year.


The Committee, however, continues its activity, and hopes all members of the Family will retain this same spirit of enthusiasm toward the day when we can again assemble in annual reunion.

DESCENDANT OF PIONEER JACOB KOLB. Died September 14, 1942. Aged 77 years, 6 months and 10 days. Born near Sellersville, Bucks County, Penna. Member of the Rockhill Mennonite Congregation. Member of the Kulp Family History Committee. President of the Mennonite Historical Society. Organizer and President of the Rockhill Cemetery Association. Director of the Telford Building and Loan Association. Member of the Building Committee of the New Rockhill Mennonite Church, built in 1925. Served as Superintendent of the Sunday School for many years. Collaborator in the collection of material for the "History of the Mennonites of Franconia Conference". Creator and copyist of "Illuminated Manuscripts". His record will serve as his proudest monument.
