MRS. HILDA KOCH
Who We Welcome as Our Guest Speaker.

A refugee from Germany in 1938. Hilda Koch fled to the United States to bring up her young son. Later joined by her husband, she has long gained U.S. citizenship, and her family is now as typically American as one could hope to find.

Inspired by her interest in the future of her former homeland and gifted with a remarkable insight into the problems and solutions of human relations, Hilda Koch has become well known in recent years as a traveller, author and lecturer. Since the conclusion of World War Two, Mrs. Koch has twice revisited Germany; her last visit during the summer of 1952, included France, Switzerland, large parts of Germany and Berlin.

Since her return, she has undertaken to address numerous civic groups, lecturing with the Speakers Research Committee for the U.N. and the American Friends Service Committee.

Hilda Koch addresses herself principally to the human problems of living in a divided city, such as Berlin; problems of the occupation as observed particularly in Koblenz; youth receiving camps for the myriads of adolescent refugees from East Germany; and her reactions to the human developments of victor and vanquished in Europe today.
