In the cemetery of the Plain Mennonite Church, Lansdale, Pa., is the resting place of Rev. Jacob Kulp and his wife, Catharine. Rev. Jacob Kulp, born Oct. 5, 1798; died June 27, 1875. Married Catharine Hunsicker, June 1, 1828. A Mennonite by faith and in his youth a great reader and deep student. Chosen to the ministry Aug. 2, 1838 and ordained a Bishop Dec. 21, 1843.

A great grandson, William F. Kulp and a great-great grandson, Homer C. Kulp, both of Harleysville, Pa., have been officially connected with the Kulp Family Association for a number of years.
