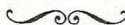

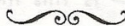


Farm-Homestead of Squire Joseph Kolb and his wife Catherine

OUR GUEST SPEAKER

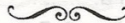
REV. JAMES G. PENLINGTON



We are pleased to have with us today to speak to us the Rev. James G. Penlington, Pastor of the Valley Forge Baptist Church. Rev. Penlington was born December 1st, 1913 in Birdsboro, Pa. In his youth he enjoyed engagement in the various activities, social and religious. A graduate of the Class of 1932 from the Tredyffrin - Easttown High School; attended the Bible School, Pennsylvania Bible Institute, Phila., Pa.; The Kings College, Briarcliff Manor, New York, where he attained a B. S. Degree in 1942; also the Eastern Baptist Seminary at Overbrook, Pa. receiving a B.Th. Degree in 1944.

He was active in the Chester County Christian Endeavor, President of the East Branch in 1938.

His college activities included basketball in his freshman year; Manager of varsity in his senior year and 3 years varsity catcher on the baseball team. He was a member of the Men's Literary Society; Men's Glee Club and Photographer for the Year Book in his senior year. Also president of the Junior Class in College and speaker for one of the gospel teams in his sophomore year.
