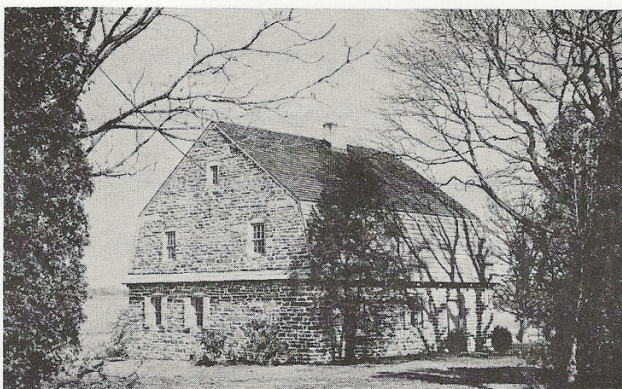


FOURTIETH ANNUAL REUNION

This program is dedicated to the memory of our ancestor, Dielman Kolb, who arrived in America two hundred and fifty years ago. Of Dutch Mennonite descent, he came from the Rhine Valley, following the example of his four brothers, who arrived here ten years earlier. The above photo shows his home, built prior to 1748, near Lederach, Pa. The exterior of the house has been beautifully restored to its original appearance by Mr. and Mrs. Philip R. Detwiler. 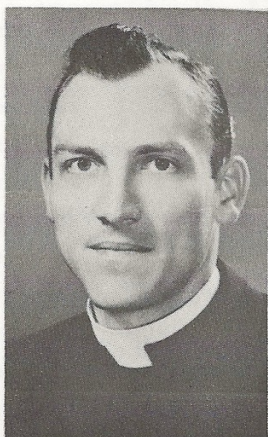

The speaker of the afternoon is the Rev. Donald R. Schaeffer, Pastor of Grace Lutheran Church, Hatfield, Pa.

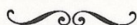
The Rev. Mr. Schaeffer was born in December of 1923 at Pottstown, Pa. He was raised at the Lutheran Home at Topton, Pa. He was educated in the public schools of Topton, Pa. and Kutztown, Pa.

He served our country during the second world war in England, France and Germany. Wounded in action in February, 1945. Awarded the Purple Heart and Bronze Star with Oak Leaf Cluster.

He graduated from Reading High School and entered Muhlenberg College to prepare for the ministry. He graduated from Lutheran Theological Seminary, Mt. Airy, Pa. and was ordained to the ministry in May, 1952.

The Rev. Mr. Schaeffer has served Pastorates in Reading, Lock Haven, and Selinsgrove, Pa., prior to assuming the Pastorate of Grace Church in Hatfield, in February of 1965. He is married to Lucille Hartung of Chester County and is the father of two daughters and a son. He is presently serving as Chaplain of Hatfield Post, American Legion.

Our guest singer is Mr. Rein F. Gottshall of Royersford, Pa., 86 year old Dunker "Vorsinger," and Penna. Dutch Folksinger of wide reputation. Mr. Gottshall sings annually at the Pennsylvania Dutch Folk Festival at Kutztown, Pa., and has sung to large audiences through the facilities of Philadelphia area radio and T.V. stations.
