Our speaker chose the photo at left because it illustrates grandmother Anna Kolb Bean, here holding him in 1928! As a child, playing in the attic, he found old family records (in German) and inquired what they said. This started many years of interest in genealogy.

He was trained and employed as an electrical engineer for most of his working life. This naturally led him to an interest in computers and the thought that genealogy records in that form was much easier to use than old books and papers. As a result, he now has computer genealogy records on the Kulp, Bean, Gottshall, Moyer/Maier, and Wisler families. He and his wife are also directors of the Skippack Historical Society and are doing research on many 200-year-old houses in the Skippack area.
