MRS. NANCY ROAN**

Mrs. Nancy Roan, of Bechtelsville, PA, is well known for her intense interest in the history of Pennsylvania Dutch quilts and quilting and also in Pennsylvania Dutch foods and cooking. She has applied her knowledge to public lectures and demonstrations of traditional cooking. She serves as home skills and food consultant to the Goshenshoppen Historians' Folk Festival. As editor-in-chief, she produced "Boyer-town Cooking", a compendium of Pennsylvania Dutch recipes. A paper she wrote on Pennsylvania Dutch foods appeared in "From Pennsylvania to Waterloo" (Canada, Burke & Hill, Ed's).

In 1983 her interest in Quilts and Quilting began when she, along with Ellen Gehret, compiled "Just a Quilt". Since then she has conducted her research on Pennsylvania Dutch quilts and quilters, and has presented papers which reflect her research at two Oral Traditional Symposiums. An active quilter and member of the Variable Star Quilters, she assisted that group in producing the "Quilter Ladies' Scrapbook" and the "WPA Museum Project of Quilt Patterns".

She and her husband, "Abe" co-authored "Lest I Shall Be Forgotten" from the Montgomery County, PA quilt documentation project.

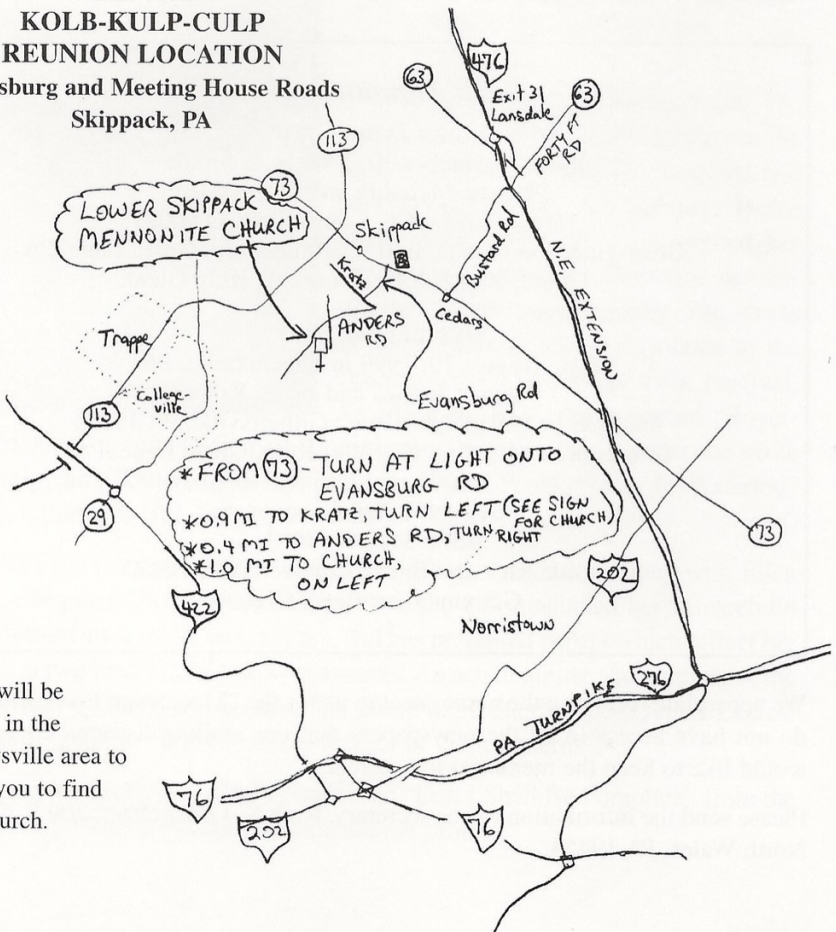
